- Secretary Report. March 14, 2020 minutes were presented by Secretary Roth. Motion: Borzick/Muchka to approve minutes as presented. Approved.
 Treasurer's Report. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, fiscal year 2019/2020 was extended one month. Treasurer Muchka presented extended budget for approval. Motion: Borzick/Roth to approve Treasurer's Report. Approved.

6. Old Business:

a. Lake Levels. Denny McCain has been keeping records of the fluctuating levels this summer. He presented a graph and photos documenting this. Commissioner has been in contact with Hanna Johnson, DNR, dam compliance. She has met with the dam operator in order to review the daily records. According to his journal, the levels are in compliance. It is unclear if the ruler at the dam is accurately in place. Ms. Johnson she would look into the accuracy of it. Since journal entries are entered manually, the Homeowners are concerned of accuracy and suggest an unannounced visit to the dam.

7. New Business:
